



Holy Week Wheel Printable Craft

An Easter week craft for the whole class!

(designed for 1-4)



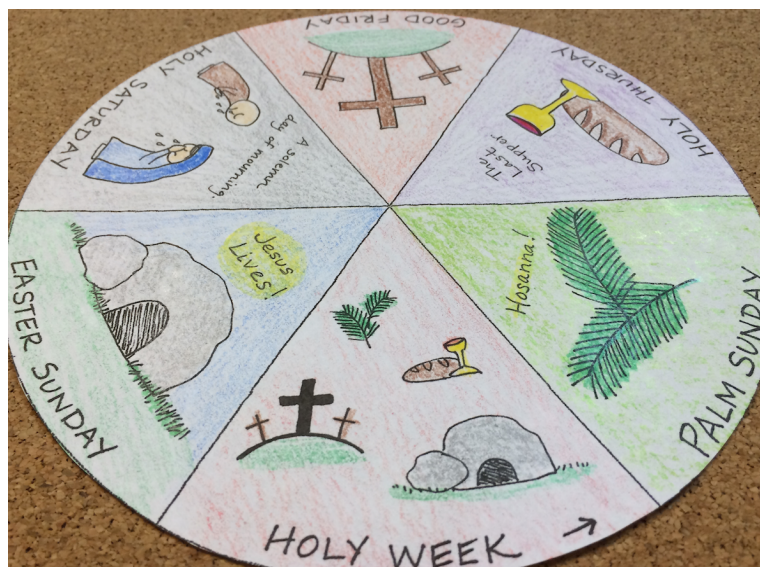
This Holy Week Wheel guides your students through the most important events leading up to the death and resurrection of Jesus. Using simple images to tell the story, it begins with Palm Sunday and includes Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday. Students simply color, cut, and fasten the two pieces together for a fun and useful Easter craft!



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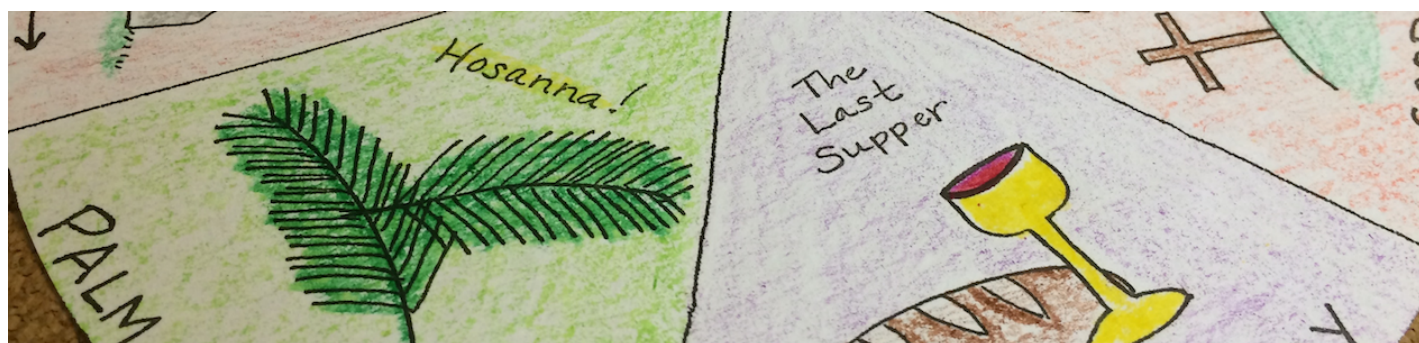
Materials:

- white cardstock or construction paper
- 2 wheel templates (included)
- paper fasteners (1 per student)
- Crayons, colored pencils, or markers
- Scissors



Directions:

1. Copy one wheel set for each student on cardstock or construction paper.
2. Instruct students to write their name on the cover wheel before coloring.
3. Students may color both parts of the wheel as they wish.
4. Use scissors to cut around the edge of both circles. On the cover wheel, cut along the lines below the words "Holy Week" to create an open space.
5. Help students poke a hole in the middle of each wheel (use pen or fastener)
6. Attach the paper fastener, securing the two parts of the wheel loosely.
7. Enjoy turning the wheel to walk through the days of Holy Week!
